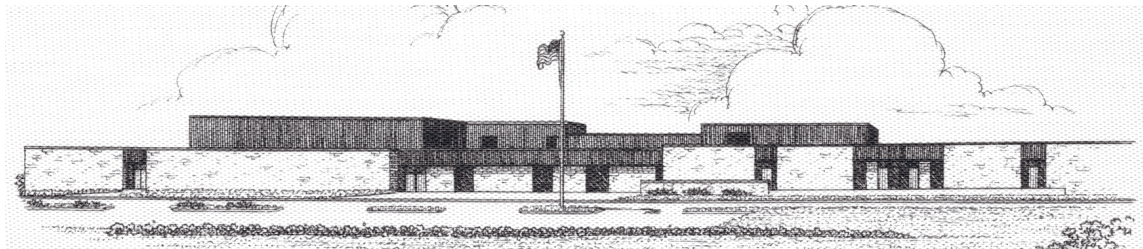

## Chromebook User and Internet Usage Agreement

### Purpose

Chromebooks are provided to students in the Kingsley-Pierson Community School District to enhance learning and support instruction. All students are expected to use their assigned Chromebook responsibly, respectfully, and in accordance with school policies.

### Use of School Devices

The devices and related items are the property of the District and are being provided to the student as a courtesy. Use of the device, as well as access to the District's technology systems, is a privilege and not a right and must be in accordance with District policies and procedures as well as applicable laws. The District may collect and/or inspect the device at any time, including via electronic remote access, with or without prior notice. Students should understand that they have no expectation of privacy in the device and that any data in the device is not considered private.

### Student Responsibilities

- I will bring the Chromebook to school each day, fully charged.
- I will use the Chromebook only for educational purposes.
- I will not deface or damage the Chromebook or any identifying labels.
- I will not loan my Chromebook to others.
- I will only access approved websites and content as directed by Kingsley-Pierson staff.
- I will not attempt to bypass filters, install unauthorized software, or modify system settings.
- I will report any problems, damage, or loss immediately to a Kingsley-Pierson teacher or administrator.

### Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- I will supervise my child's use of the Chromebook at home.
- I will ensure the Chromebook is handled with care and returned if my child withdraws from Kingsley-Pierson.
- I understand that if the Chromebook is damaged, lost, or stolen, I may be financially responsible.

### Chromebook Care Guidelines

- Keep food and drinks away from the device.

- Carry the Chromebook with two hands or in a closed case.
- Do not place heavy objects on top of the Chromebook.
- Store the device in a safe, dry location when not in use.
- Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the Chromebook yourself.

### **Student Internet Usage Regulations**

- Students will only use the internet for school-related research, assignments, and educational activities.
- Accessing or attempting to access inappropriate, or non-educational websites is strictly prohibited.
- Students must not engage in cyberbullying, harassment, or any form of disrespectful communication online.
- Students may not share personal information (e.g., full name, address, phone number) over the internet.
- Downloading files, games, or applications without teacher approval is not allowed.
- Use of anonymous proxies, VPNs, or other methods to bypass school internet filters is forbidden.
- All internet activity is monitored by Kingsley-Pierson staff and subject to review at any time.
- Violations of internet usage policies may result in restricted access, disciplinary consequences, or both.

### **Consequences for Misuse**

- Loss of Chromebook privileges
- Disciplinary action according to the Kingsley-Pierson Student Code of Conduct
- Financial responsibility for damage, loss, or theft
- Damage or loss may result in a fine in the amount of the costs of repair or replacement, which will be charged to the student and/or parent.
